The workshop will cover:

- the key concepts of project management and help people think about the approaches for managing different projects and programmes of work
- systems thinking and complexity science and how these concepts can provide helpful insights into managing complex projects and programmes of transformational change
- the role, skills and competencies of the project/programme lead
- managing risk, reporting, oversight and governance
